

## 2010 Caledon Fair Pinto Horse Show Rules

### Fees:

- All exhibitors are required to pay a \$5 membership fee to be charged at booth.

### Prizes:

- Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place in all classes. Prize money for 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> place: \$17, \$12, \$8, \$5, \$3

### Awards:

- **Pinto Youth High Point Award** (points from classes # 2, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13).
- **Pinto Amateur High Point Award** (points from classes # 3, 8, 9, 10, 14, 15).
- **Pinto Open High Point Award** (points from classes # 1, 4, 11, 16, 17, 18).

### Rules:

- Entries to be made at ring side on show day, cash entries only please as prize money paid in cash.
- All riders must wear proper footwear for horseback riding with a heel of no less than 1.5 cm.
- SEI/ASTM certified protective headgear must be worn by all exhibitors regardless of their age.
- Protective headgear may be worn in Halter & Showmanship classes in lieu of a western hat.
- Ages of exhibitors as specified for various divisions will be as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of current year.
- Open Classes – all levels and ages of exhibitors may enter.
- Pinto Classes – open to Pinto horses only with qualifying white markings/underlying pink skin
- Pinto Classes – registration / membership is not necessary with either the Pinto Horse Association of America (PtHA) nor with the Ontario Pinto Horse Assoc. (OPtHA) for Pinto classes at Caledon Fair.
- Classes / Divisions may be combined into one for any class(es) with insufficient entries.
- Pinto Horse Association (PtHA) rules apply to all classes specified as Pinto only.
- Pinto Youth Classes – riders 18 years of age and younger may enter.
- Pinto Amateur Classes – riders 19 years of age and older who are not equine professionals.

## 2010 Caledon Fair English Horse Show Rules

### Fees:

- All exhibitors are required to pay a \$5 membership fee to be charged at booth.

### Prizes:

- Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place in all classes. Prize money for 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> place: \$17, \$12, \$8, \$5, \$3

### Awards:

- **Youth English High Point Award** (based on points from classes 1, 3, 4, 5).
- **Adult English High Point Award** (based on points from classes 2, 6, 7, 8).
- **Standardbred Performance Horse Association Award** (most points earned by a Standardbred)

### Rules:

- Entries to be made at ring side on show day, cash entries only please as prize money paid in cash.
- Classes are open to all horses, ponies & mules.
- All riders must wear proper footwear for horseback riding with a heel of no less than 1.5 cm.
- SEI/ASTM certified protective headgear must be worn by all exhibitors regardless of their age.
- Ages of exhibitors as specified for various divisions will be as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of current year.
- Youth Classes – only riders 17 years of age or younger may enter ( W/T/C)
- Adult Classes – only riders 18 years of age or older may enter (W/J/C).
- Classes / Divisions may be combined into one for any class(es) with insufficient entries.
- Warm up time will be provided between the Pinto Horse Show Classes & the English Horse Show
