1. Registered Broodmare (mare showing evidence of being in foal, a foal by side, or proof of registration for foal of current year)
2. Registered foal of the current year (2010 colt or filly to show together)
3. **All Breed Special** - Best broodmare and foal on the grounds. Broodmare and foal must be shown in their respective classes.
4. 3 years and over mare
5. Yearling filly or colt of 2009
6. 2 year old Filly or Colt foaled in 2008.
7. Gelding - any age
8. Champion Horse on the grounds - all first place entries to compete. Rosettes only.

Junior Classes

Prize Money for classes 9 & 10 - 1st \$25.00, 2nd \$20.00, all other entries \$15.00

9. Heavy horse shown by an exhibitor under 13 years of age as of January 1st, 2010.
10. Heavy horse shown by an exhibitor between the ages of 14 to 21 years of age as of January 1, 2010.
11. Champion Showman. Top two placings from classes 9 and 10 to compete. Exhibitors to switch horses and are expected to know the parts of the horse. Rosettes only.
