

2010 Caledon Fair Western Horse Show

Fees:

- All exhibitors are required to pay a \$5 membership fee to be charged at booth.
- An entry fee of \$5 per class will be charged for all classes except Leadline & Beginner classes.
- No entry fee to be charged for Leadline classes # 3, 4, & 5 and Beginner Classes # 6, 7 & 8.

Prizes:

- Ribbons to 5th place in all classes.
- Prize money for 1st to 5th place: \$17, \$12, \$8, \$5, \$3 (all classes except Leadline & Beginner classes)
- Prizes only to all exhibitors in Leadline classes & Beginner classes (no prize money awarded).

Awards:

- **Leadline High Point Award** (based on points from classes # 3, 4 & 5 as above)
- **Beginner High Point Award** (based on points from classes # 6, 7 & 8 as above)
- **Youth Western Performance High Point Award** (based on points from classes 9, & 14-16)
- **Adult Western Performance High Point Award** (based on points from classes 10 & 17 - 19)
- **Junior Games High Point Award** (points from classes 21, 23, 25, 27, 29, 31, 33, 35, 37)
- **Senior Games High Point Award** (points from classes 22, 24, 26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38)
- **Sportsmanship Award** (awarded to the exhibitor who most displays good sportsmanship)
- **Standardbred Performance Horse Association Award** (most points earned by a Standardbred)

Rules:

- Entries to be made at ring side on show day, cash entries only please as prize money paid in cash.
- Classes are open to all horses, ponies & mules.
- Classes specified as "Western" must be shown in western tack only
- Classes not specified as "Western" are open to riders of any discipline.
- All riders must wear proper footwear for horseback riding with a heel of no less than 1.5 cm.
- SEI/ASTM certified protective headgear must be worn by all exhibitors regardless of their age.
- Protective headgear may be worn in Halter & Showmanship classes in lieu of a western hat.
- Ages of exhibitors as specified for various divisions will be as of January 1st of current year.
- Open Classes – all levels and ages of exhibitors may enter.
- Leadline Classes – only riders 7 years of age or younger unable to ride unattended may enter.
- Leadline riders may not enter any Youth, Adult or Open riding classes.
- Beginner Classes – only riders not yet able to ride at the canter / lope may enter this division.
- Beginner riders may not enter any Youth or Adult riding classes.
- Youth Classes – only riders 17 years of age or younger may enter.
- Adult Classes – only riders 18 years of age or older may enter.
- Classes / Divisions may be combined into one for any class(es) with insufficient entries.
- Western Horse Association of Ontario (WHAO) rules apply unless class rules altered by Fair.
- Junior Horses are 5 years of age or younger as of January 1st of current year.
- Western leadline & beginner riders may ride a horse of any age with two hands using a snaffle.

1. **Open Halter** – all-breeds, horse is judged on conformation & movement
 2. **Open Showmanship** – all-breeds, handler is judged on ability to present horse at halter
 3. **Leadline Walk** – riders 7 years of age and under, not yet able to ride unattended by handler
 4. **Leadline Walk & Jog/Trot** – walk/jog class for leadline riders lead by handler
 5. **Leadline Obstacle Course** – simple obstacle course for leadline riders attended by handler
 6. **Beginner Walk & Jog/Trot** – riders able to ride unattended but not yet ready to lope
 7. **Beginner Walk & Jog/Trot Game** – game open to beginner level riders only
 8. **Beginner Walk & Jog/Trot Obstacle Course** – obstacle course for beginner level riders
- Break / Warm Up Time for Youth & Adult Riders (approximately 20 min.)*
9. **Youth Trail** – youth riders complete a pattern of trail obstacles such as gate, bridge, poles, etc.
 10. **Adult Trail** – adult riders complete a pattern of trail obstacles such as gate, bridge, poles, etc.
- Short Break While Trail Class Removed From Show Ring*
11. **Junior Horse Pleasure (non-point class)** – open to horses 5 years of age and under
 12. **Open Walk & Jog/Trot (non-point class)** – open walk/jog or walk/trot class for all levels of riders
 13. **Open Steady Hand (non-point class)** – ride holding a cup of water, most water remaining wins
 14. **Youth Western Pleasure** – horses are shown at a walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring
 15. **Youth Western Horsemanship** – riders judged on seat, hands, etc. while performing a pattern
 16. **Youth Western Discipline Rail Horse** – horse judged on how well commands are performed
 17. **Adult Western Pleasure** – horses are shown at a walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring
 18. **Adult Western Horsemanship** – riders judged on seat, hands, etc. while performing a pattern
 19. **Adult Western Discipline Rail Horse** – horse judged on how well commands are performed
- 20. Break /Tack Change / Warm Up Time for Games Riders (approximately 20 min.)*
21. **Junior Catalogue Race** – race to barrel, tear out assigned page number from catalogue, return
 22. **Senior Catalogue Race** – race to barrel, tear out assigned page number from catalogue, return
 23. **Junior Scudaho** – race around 4 poles, 3 barrels and over 1 jump (maximum height 12 inches)
 24. **Senior Scudaho** – race around 4 poles, 3 barrels and over 1 jump (maximum height 12 inches)
 25. **Junior Texas Speed & Action** – through box, around barrel & back, then go again other way
 26. **Senior Texas Speed & Action** – through box, around barrel & back, then go again other way
 27. **Junior Big T Race** - weave through poles, around barrels in “figure 8”, weave back to end
 28. **Senior Big T Race** - weave through poles, around barrels in “figure 8”, weave back to end
 29. **Junior Stake Race** – race a figure 8 pattern around two poles without going outside markers
 30. **Senior Stake Race** – race a figure 8 pattern around two poles without going outside markers
 31. **Junior Polebending** – race a weaving pattern between six poles without knocking any down
 32. **Senior Polebending** – race a weaving pattern between six poles without knocking any down
 33. **Junior Barrel Race** – race a pattern around three barrels without knocking any barrels over
 34. **Senior Barrel Race** – race a pattern around three barrels without knocking any barrels over
 35. **Junior Flag Race** – race to barrel, pick up flag, around end barrel, back to centre, put flag in
 36. **Senior Flag Race** – race to barrel, pick up flag, around end barrel, back to centre, put flag in
 37. **Junior Dash for Cash** – race to end of ring, around barrel and back without knocking barrel
 38. **Senior Dash for Cash** – race to end of ring, around barrel and back without knocking barrel
