

Livestock Rules and Regulations

Health Rules and Regulations

1. General - Health Certificates will be issued without charge by Veterinarians of Animal Health, Agriculture, and Agri - Food Canada, who will make all necessary examinations and conduct all the required tests.
2. All Purebred animals must be registered and pedigrees must be produced at the Fair when requested by the Directors in charge. Junior Calves are exempt from this rule demanding pedigrees.
3. General Rules of Caledon Agricultural Society apply.
4. Tests for Tuberculosis are required to cover cattle originating from:
 - (a) Herds dealt with under the Accredited Herd plan in good standing; or,
 - (b) Herds in accredited areas in good standing.All other cattle will be required to pass a negative test within 60 days of the opening date of the fair.
5. Brucellosis - No test required, Ontario is rated as Brucellosis free.
6. The owners of cattle to be exhibited should contact the District Office of the Health of Animals Branch in their area to make arrangements to have the test conducted. Entries should be accompanied by Health Certificate Form HA-4
7. No cattle will be allowed to enter the Fair unless they meet the above requirements.

Show Rules and Regulations

1. Membership Fee: All entrants must pay a \$5.00 membership fee to the Caledon Agricultural Society.
2. Fifteen percent (15%) of all prize money over \$10.00 will be retained by the Caledon Agricultural Society as Entry Fees.
3. For the purpose of identification of animals as to their proper classes, you are asked to have their Certificate of Registration available upon request.
4. Sections will be judged in the order they appear in this section unless otherwise stipulated.
