### Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (O.A.A.S.) Annual Quilt Competition

#### PLEASE READ THE OAAS RULES CAREFULLY

Hand Quilting Classes: 569 to 591 / Machine Quilting Classes: 558 to 568

Indicate on the back of the entry tag if you wish to participate in the Ontario Associations Annual Quilt Competition.

#### General Rules and Eligibility Requirements

1. Entries must be solely made and quilted by a group or individual and exhibited and judged at a local Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies' (O.A.A.S.) Fair to be eligible for this competition.
2. Entry quilts must be a Minimum of 72" X 90" (170cm X 210cm) (smaller quilts will not be eligible to proceed to the next levels of competition).
3. Judging will occur at local fairs and then district levels. A Provincial Grand Champion Quilt will be selected at the Annual Convention (Feb. 2011 – The Royal York Hotel, Toronto)
