

**Pictures and Wall Hangings** \*\*\*Sample of material must be attached\*\*\*

State if a kit or original design. All Wall Hangings must be ready to hang. All Pictures must be framed.

608. Embroidered picture or wall hanging.  
 609. Needle point picture.  
 610. Hand stitched picture, any technique.

611. Counted Cross Stitch Wall hanging.  
 612. Counted Cross Stitch Picture.  
 613. Paper Tole Picture.

**Silk and Dried Flowers, Fruit and Nature's Treasures**

614. Silk Flower Corsage, mounted for display.  
 615. Wrist Corsage, mounted for display.  
 616. Straw Hat, decorated, to hang on wall.  
 617. Door or Wall hanging using silk or dried flowers.  
 618. Mantelpiece arrangement, using silk or dried flowers.  
 619. Wreath, using silk or dried flowers.

620. Table arrangement, using dried natural or artificial flowers and/or fruit – no larger than 24" X 24".  
 621. Braided or woven article or basket from straw or other natural materials.  
 622. Topiary Item, no larger than 24" x 24".  
 623. Bride's Nosegay and Groom's Boutonniere, mounted and displayed together.

**Ceramics and Pottery**

624. Ceramic article in Stains.  
 625. Ceramic Article in Under glazing.  
 626. Ceramic Article in Glaze.

627. Pottery piece-thrown, fired, with or without glaze.  
 628. Pottery piece, slab, coil or hand built- must be fired, with or without glaze.

**Items Made For Children** \*\*\*sample of material must be attached\*\*\*

629. Knitted or Crocheted Toy.  
 630. Stuffed Animal.  
 631. Handmade Toy, any technique.  
 632. Rag Doll.

633. Doll Outfit, mounted or on a doll.  
 634. Teddy Bear.  
 635. A Puppet.  
 636. Wooden Toy- not from a kit.

**Decorative Arts** \*\*\*Sample of materials must be attached\*\*\*

637. Article of folk art painting on wood or tin, shelf size.  
 638. Article of stencilling on paper, wood or fabric.  
 639. Article of liquid embroidery or fabric painting.  
 640. Article of Paper Mache.

641. Article of Stone Painting.  
 642. Cushion Cover, sewn-not to include the cushion or filler.  
 643. Sewn Door Stopper or Draft Catcher.  
 644. Painted Canvas Rug or Wall hanging.

**Miscellaneous**

645. Jewellery, original design.  
 646. Hand decorated note paper, card or wrapping paper.  
 647. Three (3) Bazaar Items, each a different technique.  
 648. Any article made from plastic canvas or canvas.  
 649. Decorated egg (one egg only, must be a real egg).  
 650. Wreath or hanging article, not using silk or dried flowers.  
 651. Homemade Candle.  
 652. Fabric book cover, displayed on a book or album.  
 653.3 Scrapbook pages covering a single theme, protected in a plastic cover.

656. Scrapbook cover.  
 657. Small article of counted cross stitch no larger than 2".  
 658. Hair Ornament.  
 659. Item of tooled leather.  
 660. Article made from Friendly Plastic or modelling compound.  
 661. Craft demonstrating Fair theme: Turn Back the Clock  
 662. Decorative or useful item made of glass- painted, stained or slumped.  
 663. Any craft not previously listed-name technique used.
