The Original Caledon Strawberry Festival has been held on the village fairgrounds since 1988, run solely by volunteers from the community and sponsored by the Caledon Agricultural Society. Our attendance ranges from 3,000 – 5,000 annually with most participants being local residents.

Again this year on July 1st this popular event celebrates Canada's birthday and the strawberry season with family fun, entertainment, displays, craft tables, free balloons and cake, and of course lots of strawberries. Admission and parking is free.

Revenue generated on July 1st ensures the continuance of this popular event thanks in large part to the generosity of our silent auction donors throughout the community. This part of the event has raised \$3,000 to \$4,000 in the past and creates considerable enthusiasm.
