Classes:

1. **Open Costume Class** – dress your horse and yourself up and show off your costume at the fair
2. **Open Musical Cones** – ride around, find an empty “stall” when the music stops, last one wins
3. **Open Egg & Spoon** – ride carrying an egg on a spoon without dropping it, last egg wins
4. **Open Ride-A-Buck** – ride with a paper “buck” under your leg, last one with buck wins
5. **Junior Catalogue Race** – race to barrel, tear out assigned page number from catalogue, return
6. **Senior Catalogue Race** – race to barrel, tear out assigned page number from catalogue, return
7. **Junior Scudaho** – race around 4 poles, 3 barrels and over 1 jump (maximum height 12 inches)
8. **Senior Scudaho** – race around 4 poles, 3 barrels and over 1 jump (maximum height 12 inches)
9. **Junior Texas Speed & Action** – through box, around barrel & back, then go again other way
10. **Senior Texas Speed & Action** – through box, around barrel & back, then go again other way
11. **Junior Big T Race** - weave through poles, around barrels in “figure 8”, weave back to end
12. **Senior Big T Race** - weave through poles, around barrels in “figure 8”, weave back to end
13. **Junior Stake Race** – race a figure 8 pattern around two poles without going outside markers
14. **Senior Stake Race** – race a figure 8 pattern around two poles without going outside markers
15. **Junior Polebending** – race a weaving pattern between six poles without knocking any down
16. **Senior Polebending** – race a weaving pattern between six poles without knocking any down
17. **Junior Barrel Race** – race a pattern around three barrels without knocking any barrels over
18. **Senior Barrel Race** – race a pattern around three barrels without knocking any barrels over
19. **Junior Flag Race** – race to barrel, pick up flag, around end barrel, back to centre, put flag in
20. **Senior Flag Race** – race to barrel, pick up flag, around end barrel, back to centre, put flag in
21. **Junior Dash for Cash** – race to end of ring, around barrel and back without knocking barrel
22. **Senior Dash for Cash** – race to end of ring, around barrel and back without knocking barrel

Fees:

- All exhibitors are required to pay a \$5 annual membership fee to Caledon Agricultural Society.
- An entry fee of \$5 per class will be charged for all classes.

Prizes:

- Ribbons to 5th place in all classes.
- Prize money for 1st to 5th place: \$10, \$8, \$6, \$4, \$2

Awards:

- **Junior Games High Point Award** (points from classes # 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21).
- **Senior Games High Point Award** (points from classes # 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22).
- **Sportsmanship Award** (awarded to the exhibitor who most displays good sportsmanship).
- **Standardbred Performance Horse Association Award** (most points earned by a Standardbred)

Rules:

- Entries to be made at ring side on show day. Cash entries please.
- All classes open to horses, ponies & mules as shown in either Western or English equipment.
- All riders must wear proper footwear for horseback riding with a heel of no less than 1.5 cm.
- SEI/ASTM certified protective headgear must be worn by all exhibitors regardless of their age.
- Proper show attire not required but long pants & shirts, short or long sleeved, with collars are.
- Classes / Divisions may be combined into one for any class(es) with insufficient entries.
- Western Horse Association of Ontario (WHAO) rules apply unless class rules altered by Fair.
- Exercise caution when entering the races as classes are run on grass, not a sand ring.
- Riders of all ages may enter Open classes.
- Junior = riders age 15 years of age and under as of January 1st of current year.
- Senior = riders age 16 years of age and older as of January 1st of current year.
- Diagrams of games patterns will be posted on show day.
